

# Cleaning Instructions for Vinyl Products

## **1. Wash the surface of your vinyl.**

For boat enclosures and other outside locations like patio enclosures, seat cushions, pool covers, etc. use our **IMAR Yacht Soap (#401)**. This product can be used on any vinyl or surrounding surface. It is a gentle soap that will not strip away any protectant previously applied to the surface and will not dry out the product being cleaned.

If mild soap is not enough to clean your vinyl or your vinyl is being used in an indoor environment, use our **IMAR Stamoid Marine Vinyl Cleaner (#603)**. Spray the cleaner onto the surface and wipe dry. If the dirt is stubborn you can allow the spray to sit for up to 5 minutes and use a soft bristle brush to loosen dirt and wipe clean.

For heavily soiled vinyl surfaces use our **IMAR Multi-Purpose Cleaner (#501)**. This product is a non-caustic cleaner designed to remove mold and mildew from vinyl and rubber surfaces. It can be used full strength (as sold in bottles) or can be mixed with varying degrees of water based on the level of soiling to be cleaned.

## **2. Protect the surface of the vinyl.**

For vinyl products that must weather harsh elements (outdoor enclosures, outdoor seat cushions, covers for pools, grills, dinghies and jet ski covers, etc), or they are located in hard to reach spots (bimini tops, fly bridge covers, etc) that are not easily cared for on a daily basis, apply our **IMAR Stamoid Marine Vinyl Cream (#601)**. The cream is a thick product that will soak deep into the surface and bond with the vinyl to create the best protection available. When applying, the product will produce a hazy look to the surface. Allow product to dry and then buff clean.

For vinyl products that are easy to reach and can be cleaned on a more regular, daily basis (vinyl located inside a boat cabin, the inside of an patio/porch/boat enclosure, vinyl used for a zero-gravity treadmill, etc.) apply our **IMAR Stamoid Marine Vinyl Spray (#602)**. Simply spray the product onto the surface and buff clean. It will keep the surface from drying out and cracking and can be used as often as you want.
