Cleaning Instructions for Clear Vinyl Products

(Initially and then every 6-8 weeks follow steps 1 and 2)

1. Wash the surface of your clear vinyl.

For boat enclosures and other outside locations like patio enclosures use our IMAR Yacht Soap (#401). This product can be used on your entire boat. It is a gentle soap that will not strip wax or polish. If your clear vinyl is being used indoors, use a wet cotton or microfiber towel to wipe away any surface dirt before applying polish.

2. Protect surface with IMAR Strataglass Protective Polish (#302). Once the surface is clean and dry, apply a light coat of IMAR Strataglass Polish. Apply only enough to lightly coat the surface. Allow the polish to dry completely then buff the surface clean. (Always use soft cotton or microfiber towels on the surface of clear vinyl)

(In between polishing to keep clear vinyl looking great)

3. Keep clear vinyl looking glossy

and new with IMAR Strataglass Protective Cleaner (#301). Use on a daily basis as needed. Simply spray onto the clear vinyl and buff dry. This product, like the polish, will molecularly bond with the surface of the clear vinyl to protect it from environmental hazards helping to extend the amount of time needed between polishing; removing fingerprints, repelling dirt and leaving a glossy look to the clear vinyl. Note: fingerprints can cause a permanent cloudy mark to occur on clear vinyl – especially if you have sunscreen or lotions on your hands. Use the #301 anytime you think someone might have touched the clear vinyl to avoid this from happening.
